

Spring/ Fall Camp Equipment List in tents

We encourage your Cub to use this checklist to pack their own bags (with adult supervision). Mark everything clearly with your name.

Clothing:

- Cub Uniform – to be worn to and from Camp
- Winter Coat (for cool evenings) and spring jacket (days)
- Rain Gear (a rubberized rain coat / poncho with rubberized pants)
- Rubber boots and foot-ware for outdoors
- A toque (for cool nights) and wide brimmed hat (for sunny days, also keeps the rain off of you)
- Sleepwear
- 3 pairs of underwear
- 4 pairs of warm socks, you'll need spares when others are hung to dry
- 2 pairs of long pants (“tear offs” are great since they can be changed into shorts)
- long underwear
- 2 pair of shorts (if weather permits)
- 2 shirts/turtleneck – long sleeved and warm
- 2 short sleeved shirts
- 1 sweater and/or sweatshirt to layer over your shirt
- A campfire blanket, if you have one
- A flashlight with good batteries and spare batteries

Sleeping Gear:

- Sleeping bag
- Mattress Pad
- Pillow
- Any much loved small stuffed animal (if desired)

Toilet Kit:

- Toothbrush, toothpaste
- Comb or Brush
- Face cloth and towel
- Soap in a container
- Sunscreen

Cutlery / accessories:

- portable water bottle
- small daypack for extra shirt, water bottle, snack, etc.
- Plate, knife, fork, spoon, bowl and cup. Preferably in a net bag they can hang up to dry

CLEAR instructions for any medication, Please inform a Leader

Do NOT bring radios, tape player, CD players electronic games (e.g. Game Boy), other toys or food (including gum) to camp. Books, cards, board games are welcome.

As with any camp at this time of year, we are asking parents to help their cubs provide for the weather by checking the forecast.
